

1. Steve Hornung has emailed to inform the council that he has permission from MSDC to carry out further pruning to trees in his garden (Clarence House, Stradbroke Rd.)  
FYL. Although these trees are not covered by TPOs, trees in the conservation area have similar protections to trees that have a TPO.
2. Current legislation means that council meetings from 7 May onwards will have to be public.
3. Annual parish meeting – between 1 March and 1 June. Could decide to arrange one before 7 May, thus a virtual meeting.  
Why?
  - an opportunity for parishioners to raise any issue
  - an opportunity for the council to formally lay out its actions over the last year
  - an opportunity for any group in the parish to say what's happened in the last year (nothing probably) but more importantly, lay out plans for the future
  - relatively easy to organise compared to if there was to be an in person meeting sometime between 7 May and 1 June.

Alternative – do nothing, sit tight, and see what happens!

4. A parishioner informed me that there is no drop kerb from his disabled parking place and his home. Cllr Hadingham has acted as a conduit with MSDC to see how to resolve the problem.
5. I have received one formal complaint (see item 11 on the agenda) and numerous complaining observations about your decision to recommend the district council approves retrospectively the changes to the new Baptist Chapel, and about my actions as clerk. I have also received 8 emails from one parishioner focused on the minutes of meetings, and my actions between meetings.
6. This is not meant to be ghoulish, but what will the parish council do when the Queen or Prince Philip die? I have received details from the C of E church about its preparations.
7. I contacted the chief executive of Anglian Water. His reply to the question, 'When will Fressingfield's flooding and sewerage problems be part of your budget plan?' is on the Google Drive. I will give you info on local parishes experiences at the meeting.
8. The person whom I thought may have rainfall records for the village, doesn't to keep them.
9. Elections for county councillors and the police and crime commissioner are scheduled for May. What will you do if any prospective candidate wants an opportunity to speak at a council meeting?
