For Information:

- Nick and I attended the Produce Market on 16th Oct. We met many residents and had good conversations encompassing the meaning of life and catching up on issues affecting residents. Notably, planning permission at the Old Chapel is now granted and walls have been knocked down! The next market will be in December.
